Dear Mr Sedaghat,

Thank you for your email of 29 March 2018 inviting the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) to cooperate in the **Conference on Perspectives of Advanced Radiotherapy in Middle Income Countries (PARIMICs)** to be held in Tehran, Iran from **26 to 28 September 2018**.

The IAEA would be glad to cooperate in this conference, which should now be described in all announcements and other documents as being “organized in cooperation with the International Atomic Energy Agency”.

The IAEA will announce the conference to interested Member States as soon as the first announcement is made available to us.

The IAEA might be able to award a limited number of grants to participants from Member States eligible to receive technical assistance under the IAEA’s technical cooperation programme, but this can only be confirmed at a later stage following review of the availability of budgetary resources. It is understood that the registration fee will be waived for IAEA staff members and grantees attending the conference.



The Iranian Society of Clinical Oncology shall take the appropriate steps vis-à-vis the competent national authorities so that the conference can be attended by IAEA officials and participants from IAEA Member States. The IAEA may reconsider the arrangements made should access to such officials and participants not be possible.
